

Free Sunday School Curriculum

[Calvary Curriculum.com](#) offers coloring and activity sheets for 163 Old Testament stories and 162 New Testament stories for 1st to 6th grade in both English and Spanish.

The [Episcopal Children's Curriculum \(ECC\)](#) is no longer available for purchase as a printed resource, but the entire curriculum is available as a free download on the website of the Virginia Theological Seminary. ECC is available for three age groups, Preschool/Kindergarten, Primary, and Intermediate. For each age group, there are three years of material: Shell Year (in which Baptism is studied), Chalice Year (in which the Eucharist is studied), and Cross Year (in which Worship is studied). These four units are included in every year of the curriculum: Old Testament, New Testament, Sacraments, and the Church. Every year also has material on the major events of the Church Year, including All Saints and Pentecost. The Episcopal Curriculum for Youth (ECY) is also available for download on the site.

[Fishers of Kids](#) Children's Church offers one year (five three-month quarters) of service outlines plus 150 skits and puppet skits.

[Lesson Plans that Work \(from the Episcopal Church\)](#) offers free lesson plans following the Revised Common Lectionary. There are three lessons for each Sunday: Young Children, Older Children, and Adults and intergenerational lesson for some major feast days.
